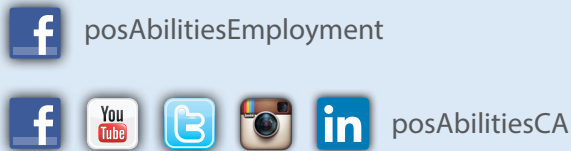

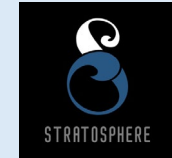
Our Service Guarantee

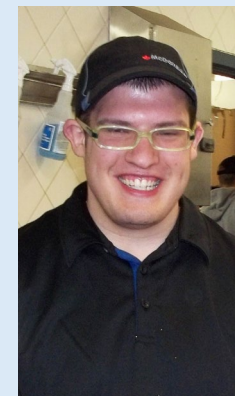


Michael is interested in building a career in retail and enjoys working at London Drugs.
