

Speech and Language Pathologist

MANDATE

To provide services to work with children, caregivers and family members to recognize and change behaviour patterns that impede communication and demonstrate communication-enhancing techniques to use in different environments. The Speech Language Pathologist will work as part of multidisciplinary team including a Behavior Consultant, Behavior Interventionist and Occupational Therapist. S

The Speech Language Pathologist will:

- Complete assessments including utilizing standard tests/special equipment to assess the extent of speech, language and swallowing impairments.
- Complete, monitor and adapt therapy/intervention plans
- Assist parents/caregivers in identifying speech and language related goals and implementing recommended therapies
- Complete reports
- Make recommendations for and write justification letters to secure funding for required equipment

- Minimum one year experience in working with children with Autism Spectrum Disorder and/or concurrent disorders.
