#### RESPONSBILITIES

- Emptying clothing and other hard goods from donation bins and other locations
- Clean up any debris surrounding bin
- Load and unload truck at determined locations; majority of job is loading and unloading
- Maintain a good pace throughout the day to achieve targets
- Move bins to desired locations as required
- Maintain good working order of the vehicles by performing regular inspections and maintenance duties such as cleaning and fueling
- Maintain excellent reports such as work, vehicle, bin and log books records

## **REQUIREMENTS**

- Completion of a Grade 10, or the equivalent education and experience
- Six month's relevant work experience in commercial vehicle operations
- Geographical knowledge of the lower mainland
- Excellent physical fitness and condition required
- Demonstrated ability to work independently and within a team setting, with an emphasis on demonstrating self-initiative, patience, maturity and tact
- Class 5 Drivers License with acceptable driving record and abstract
