

YVR helps travellers with autism gain confidence to fly

Vancouver International Airport (YVR) hosted Autism Aviation Day on Nov. 1, offering a "learn to fly" tour for over 70 participants aged 3 to 41. In partnership with the Canucks Autism Network and Air Canada, the event guided individuals and families through security screening, boarding an Air Canada Express aircraft and a short taxi on the airplane. The initiative aimed to reduce anxiety, remove travel barriers, and build confidence for travellers on the autism spectrum.
