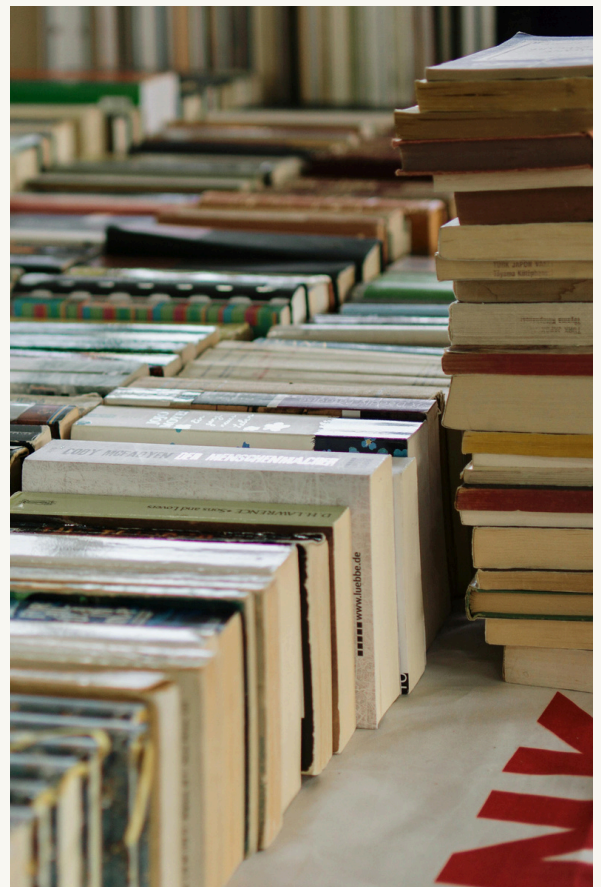

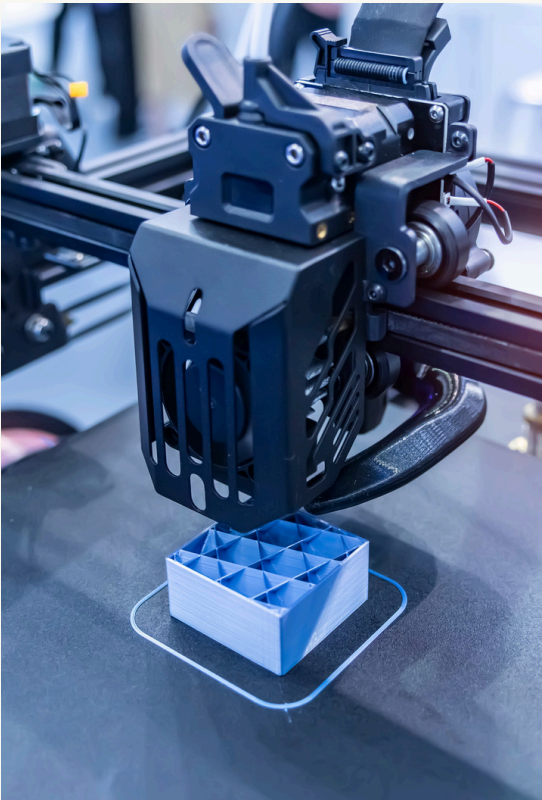

Surrey Schools to hire more educational support workers following years of budget cuts

Surrey Schools is investing in student supports by hiring 40 inclusive educational support workers and expanding mental health programs to more high schools, despite a projected \$3.8-million operating shortfall next year. However, parents say the additions do not fully replace last year's cuts, which included layoffs and program closures. The district also faces declining enrolment linked to federal immigration policy changes, which could reduce future funding as well.
