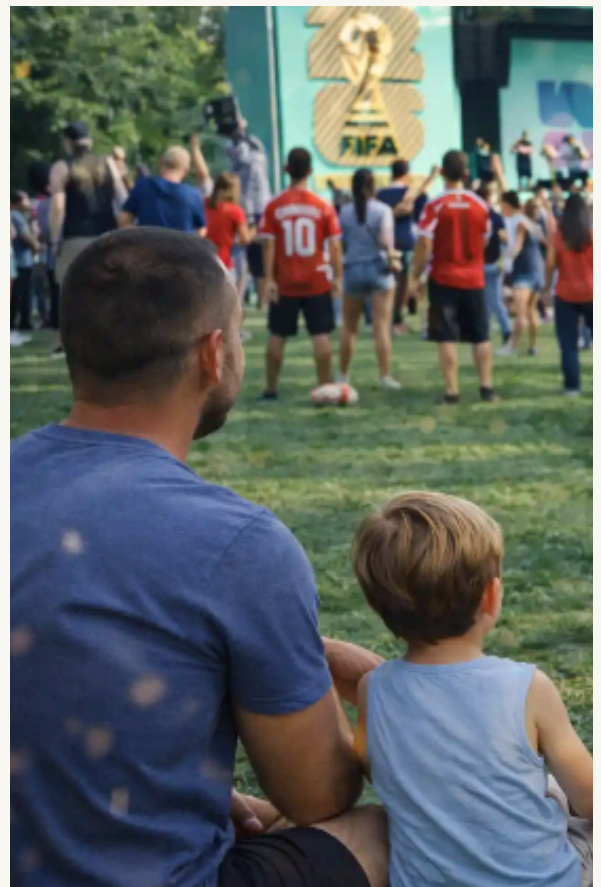

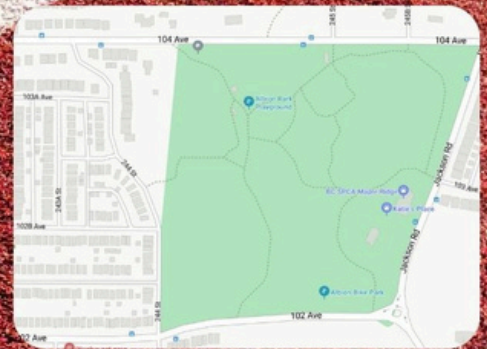
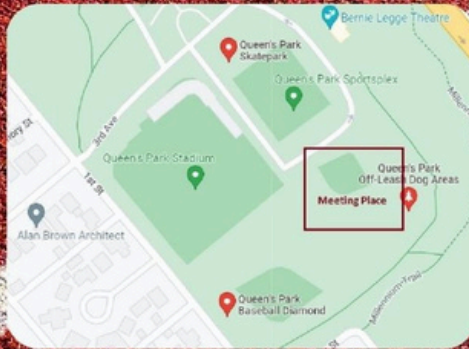

Park Board improves visitor experience in destination parks through digital accessibility mapping

The Vancouver Board of Parks and Recreation has launched a pilot program to improve accessibility in parks and trails. Visitors to Stanley Park, Queen Elizabeth Park, John Hendry Park, and New Brighton Park can now access interactive accessibility maps for trip planning and navigation. In partnership with AccessNow and supported by Destination Vancouver, the initiative provides detailed information on trail conditions, terrain, and amenities, helping create more inclusive and accessible outdoor experiences for all visitors.
