TIFF 2026 to open with Siân Heder's disability rights drama 'Being Heumann'

A drama about U.S. disability rights activist Judy Heumann, whose advocacy helped transform accessibility laws around the world, will open the Toronto International Film Festival, organizers announced. "Being Heumann" is an Apple Original film from Siân Heder. The Toronto-shot film stars Ruth Madeley as Heumann, alongside Mark Ruffalo, Dylan O'Brien, Madeline Delp, Ray Fisher and Daniel Durant. Based on Heumann's memoir, the drama centers on a historic 28-day sit-in at a federal building in San Francisco in 1977, where she led more than 100 people with disabilities in a landmark protest demanding stronger accessibility laws.
