B.C. homeowner fights strata to keep crucial emotional support cat in bylaw dispute

A B.C. homeowner is fighting her strata after being ordered to remove her emotional support cat because of the building's pet bylaws. The case has gone to the Civil Resolution Tribunal, where she argues the cat is essential to her well-being. The dispute highlights the challenges some pet owners face when strata rules conflict with disability-related needs and accommodation rights.
